The distinctive, sulfur-like odor of natural gas can be a sure sign of a leak, but some leaks don't have an odor at all.

Use your other senses to detect a leak:

- Hissing, whistling or roaring sounds
- Dirt blowing into the air from a hole in the ground
- Continuous bubbling in water
- Dead or dying vegetation in an otherwise moist area
- DO NOT use the telephone or any electrical appliances – including light switches, garage door openers, doorbells, radios, TVs, cell phones, e-cigarettes or vape pens. A spark from any of these sources could ignite the gas, causing a fire or explosion.
- DO NOT go back inside your home or building until RIE say it is safe to return

Consider installing a Natural Gas Detector (NGD) if you don't already have one.
